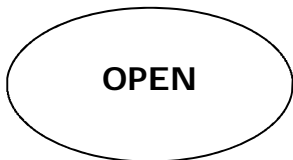

## Church Rummage Sale Taking Place During Covered Bridge



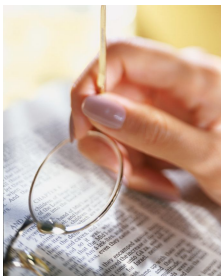

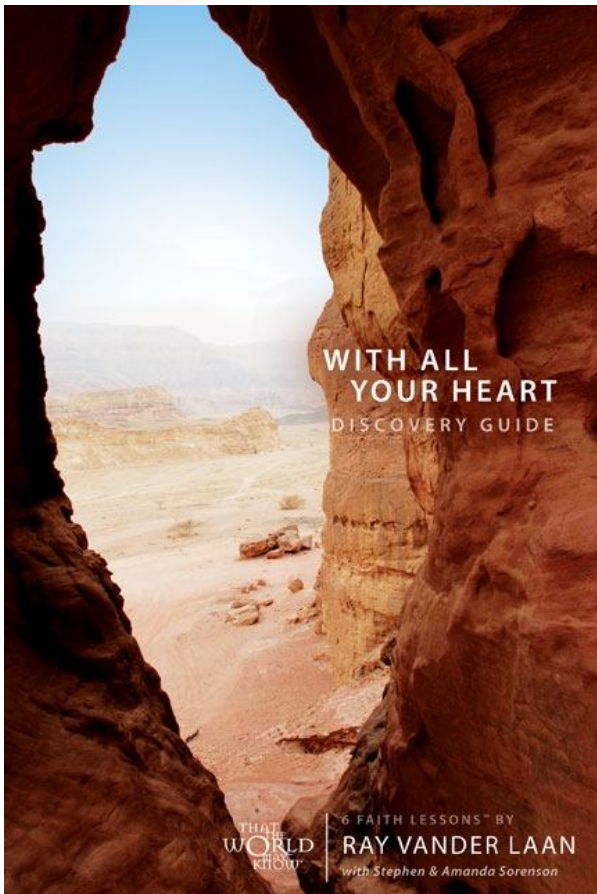

Now imagine walking with them through the Sinai desert to “The Promised Land” as God teaches them some hard, but lasting lessons in trust and obedience.

This is the beauty of the Bible study series, “**That the World May Know**”, produced by Focus on the Family and hosted by the noted teacher and author Ray Vander Laan. Filmed on location in Egypt, the Sinai Peninsula and Israel, this series makes the Bible and its people come alive in powerful new ways, connecting the ancient story with the challenges faced by Christians today.

Over the next few months, starting September 18, Pastor Dave will be leading this exciting study on **Sunday evenings, from 6-7:30 p.m.** (except during the Covered Bridge Festival). Each session will include helpful background info, a compelling video segment, and plenty of time for discussion and questions. So whether you’re new to Bible study or a long-time Bible student, you’ll find this series to be understandable, stimulating, and relevant to everyday life.

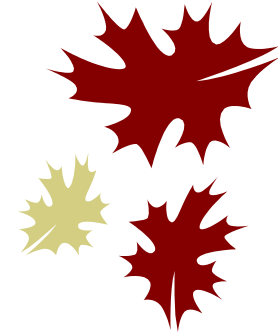

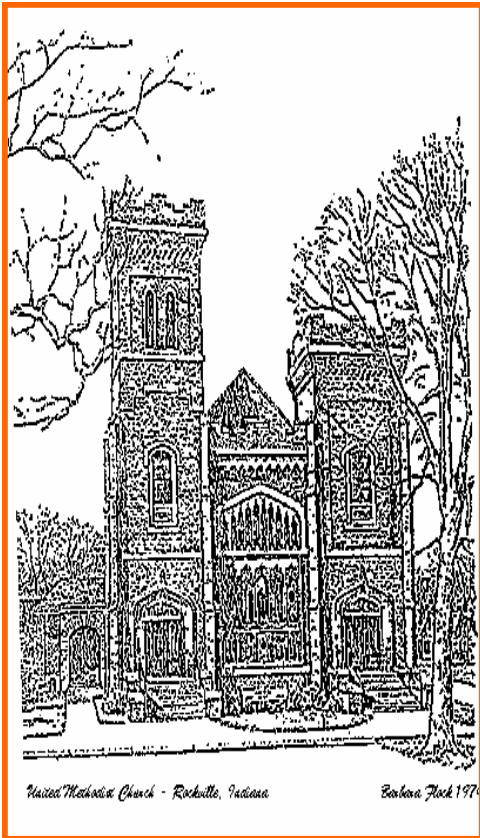
